Afiah Zabre: Abstract

Ac.Sé (Accueil Sécurisant/ Safe Home) is the French National Program for assisting and protecting victims of human trafficking. Created in 2001, the Program is a useful tool in combating human trafficking. However, it still can be improved as the criminal actions and victim's typology are changing. The program must also be improved to provide an adapted response to traffickers.

Indeed, at each level of the fight, there are still levers to activate for the program to be more relevant: creation of a national referral mechanism, more shelters to welcome victims in danger, find the why and how type of victims are changing, adapt our way of assisting them, strengthen training on the subject.

2nd National plan against human trafficking established actions and measures to be implemented during this period (Document 1).

National Advisory Commission on Human Rights pointed out what was well done by French government and what is to improve regarding trafficking (Document 2).
